He informed members that it will be announced to the public that not Covid testing is required but social distancing is for the concert series. He informed members that the crowd is at about 2500 which is very manageable.

Mr. Wojtaszek provided a Hotel update with Mr. Dave Hart of Hart Hotels via phone with the committee and discussed steps to gain business back from the pandemic with a mission of syncing with staff, operations, accounting, and reporting, etc.

Mr. Wojtaszek presented Resolution #27-2021 for the purchase of a stage lighting package from Audio Images Sound & Lighting Inc. to provide various equipment and lighting for performers at the 2021 Batavia Downs Concert Series.

Mr. Schiano reported that through May 23, EZ Bets have handled \$3.1 million up over \$1.7 million from 2020. Sean mentioned the How-To Bet event held at the Dr's Inn on May 14. He also noted the Grand Opening Party for Station 26 in Cohocton, Steuben County is scheduled for Friday June 4 starting at 3:00 PM. Norm Schneider's family has been invited and a large group is expected. Page's in Depew, Erie County should be reopened for Belmont Stakes, and Scruples in Newfane, Niagara County is reopening in the next month as well.

Mr. Schiano reported Batavia Bets handled \$1.6 million in April, up over \$807,000 or 96%. Through May 23, handle was \$1,775,000 up \$981,000 or 123%. Year to date handle is \$7.8 million up \$3.3 million or 73%. Compared to 2019 year to date handle is up over \$4 million.

Mr. Schiano reported that the due diligence continues for both the McKinley sale and the Jefferson sale.

On June 11, 2021, The New York State Gaming Commission (Commission) approved the Master Services Agreement and four addendums between Western Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation and Roberts Communications Network, LLC. The agreement and three addendums are effective January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2025. A fourth addendum is effective May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2026.
