





BISON ELEVATOR SERVICE, INC. hereinafter called the Company, proposes to furnish Preventative Maintenance, as defined in the provisions below, on the following described elevator(s):

In the Purchaser's building(s) located at:

Agreement Provisions:

The Company proposes to furnish Preventative Maintenance on the above listed equipment under this Agreement and will maintain the elevator equipment on the terms and conditions subsequently set forth.

The Company will use trained men directly employed and supervised by the Company. The Company will use all reasonable care to maintain the elevator equipment in proper and safe operating condition.

The Company will regularly and systematically examine, adjust, lubricate as required and if, in the Company's judgment, conditions warrant, repair or replace: MACHINE, MOTOR, GENERATOR, VALVES, PUMP AND CONTROLLER PARTS including Worms, Gears, Thrusts, Bearings, Brake Magnet Coils, Brake Shoes, Brushes, Windings, Commutators, Coils, Contacts, Rotating Elements, and other mechanical parts.

The Company will renew guide shoe gibs or guide rollers, as conditions warrant to ensure smooth and quiet operation and, except where roller guides are used, keep the guide rails properly lubricated.

The Company will repair or replace conductor cables as needed.

The Company will examine, lubricate, adjust and as conditions warrant, repair, or replace all accessory equipment with exceptions as stated hereinafter.


